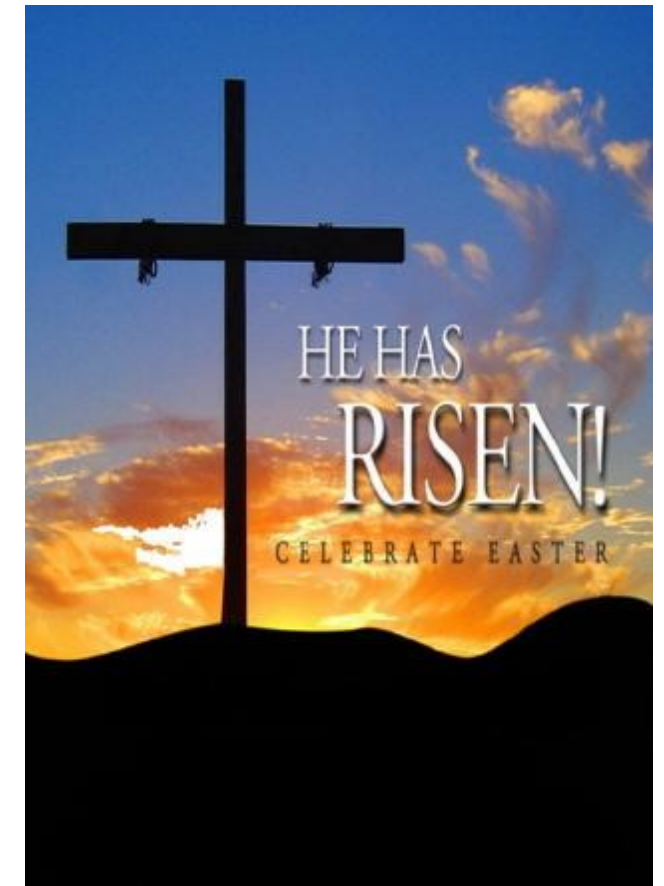

Communion is being served by the ancient practice of intinction.

Please use the center aisle to go to a communion station as directed by an usher. Receive a piece of bread, dip it into the cup, partake of both together, and return to your seat via a side aisle.

Gluten free stations are available, if desired.

The United Methodist Church practices open communion, meaning that *anyone* who desires a relationship with Christ is welcome at the table.

The cup contains unfermented grape juice, in response to the United Methodist position of alcohol abstinence.
